Dear Parents,

Thank you so much for your enrollment in Greek School! We are happy to have you aboard and look forward to helping you and your family learn about our amazing Greek culture and incredible language!

Our first and foremost priority is to provide a high quality educational and learning experience to your children. To achieve this goal, parents and teachers need to work together both at school and at home. Your role in helping your children learn Greek is very important, especially if Greek is not the language spoken at home. Here are the expectations we encourage while you and/or your children are enrolled:

1. Please make sure your children are
 - a. In school every week
 - b. Arriving on time for class
 - c. Bringing their books, paper and pencils with them
 - d. Completing their homework and are prepared for class
2. Do not schedule other activities to conflict with Greek School. In fairness to your child, the teachers and the other students, please do not over schedule the night of Greek School.
3. Participate openly in discussions with your child's teacher – attend conferences as necessary – be a part of your child's success!
4. Participate on the Parent Board, in the classroom, or by helping out with fundraisers and community nights.
5. Help your children study their Greek lessons by choosing a set day for studying and by setting aside a couple of hours every week for studying Greek. Be consistent. It will pay off.
6. Most children understand that disruptive behavior in the classroom will have consequences. Our policy is to give students a verbal warning first, before any action is taken, and then to inform you verbally or in writing. If a student remains disruptive, he or she will be released to you for the rest of the class time.
7. Please understand that the teachers cannot be responsible for the safety of your child if the child is not in the classroom. Many parents make arrangements so that their students are to meet them in the parking lot at the end of the class session. In spite of our best efforts, once a student leaves the classroom we have no control of his/her whereabouts or well being. Please instruct your child about your safety expectations.
